Call for technical papers

We invite the national and international geothermal community to submit articles for the **XXXI Annual AGM Congress**, which will host all topics related to geothermal energy, such as: geothermal exploration, geochemistry, geology, geophysics, conceptual models, numerical modeling of reservoirs, conventional and non-conventional geothermal systems, geothermal plants, well drilling and management, direct uses and low enthalpy, geothermal education, environmental and social impacts, geothermal legislation, perception of geothermal resources and any other topic related to any sector of Mexican or global geothermal energy.

Articles must be submitted according to the following schedule (**key dates**):

Deadlines	Activity
Monday February 24, 2025	Submission of abstracts
Tuesday March 4, 2025	Response to accepted abstracts
Friday April 18, 2025	Submission of manuscripts in full
Monday May 19, 2025	Sending of presentations (pptx or PDF)

- a) Interested parties should send the title of the proposed manuscript, author(s), company or institution where they work and an email address, along with a summary in Spanish or English of no more than 500 words. The summary should be sent through this [link](#) following the template found in this [document](#).
- b) After reviewing and accepting the abstracts, the authors of the works selected for presentation (oral or poster) will be notified by email and must send their full papers through the association's email (ageomex@gmail.com) and the secretary and president of the AGM (ana.garciadiago@cfe.mx; jigmtze@hotmail.com) no later than the deadline indicated for this purpose (April 18, 2025).
- c) The full version of accepted papers must be included in the same template issued for the abstract, and must not exceed 12 pages, including tables, figures, graphs and references. If the text is in Spanish, it must include an abstract in English, and vice versa, in addition to a list of keywords.
- d) Papers selected for oral presentation will have 20 minutes, including five minutes for Q&A. The presentation can be in Spanish or English. Papers selected for poster presentation will be reserved for possible oral presentation.
- e) The organizing committee of the conference reserves the right to accept papers based on the relevance of the format and content submitted.
- f) Written proof of the submitted works will be given to the main author.
